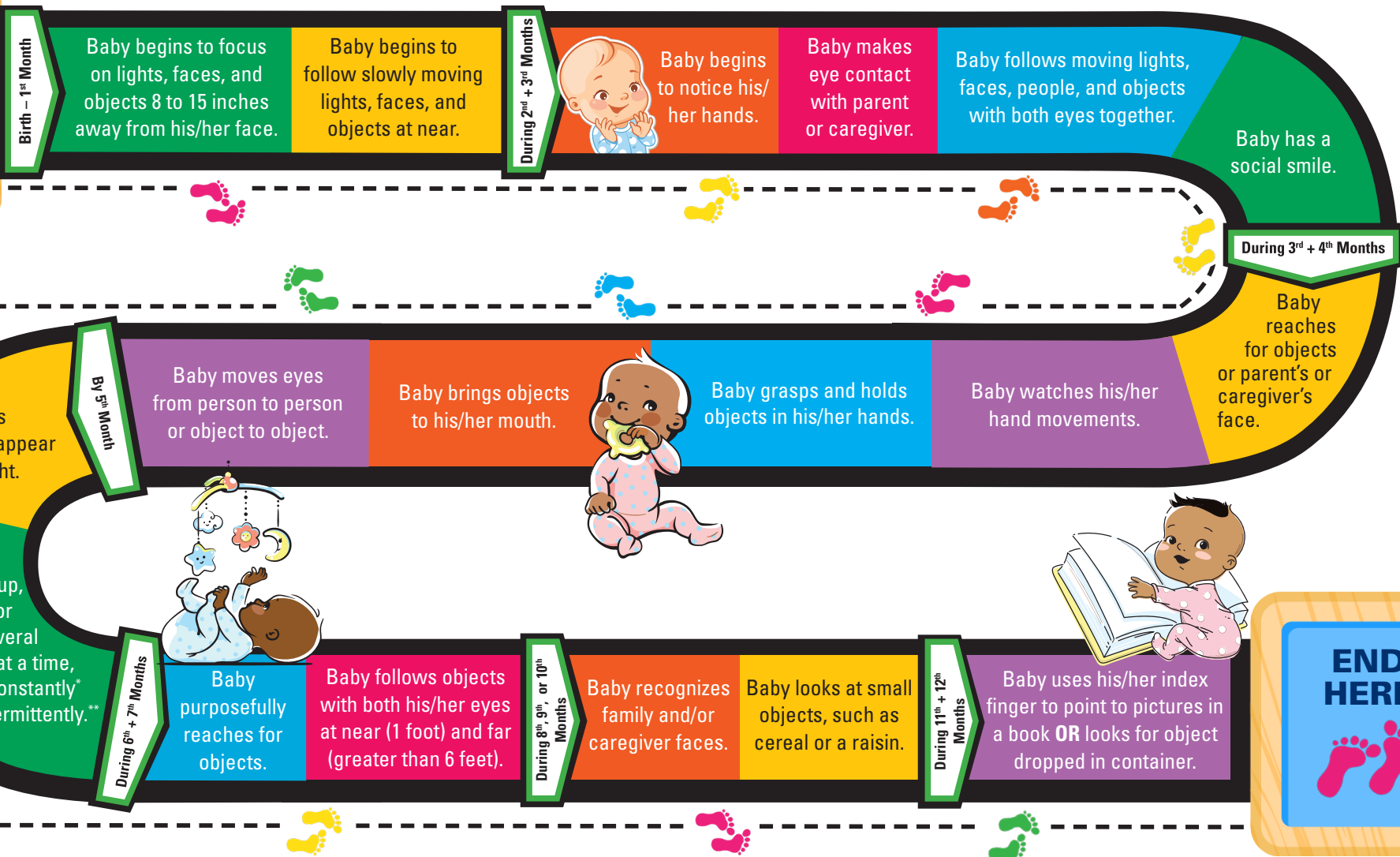


18 Vision Development Milestones From Birth to Baby's First Birthday
